

Construction Notice - Update

Barry Downe Road Infrastructure Improvements



Dear Resident,

Due to the ongoing work under the City of Greater Sudbury, Contract ENG21-30, Barry Downe Road Infrastructure Improvements, your residence may be on a temporary water supply system.

With the cold weather beginning, it is important to keep a tap in your home open enough so that the stream of water is the diameter of a pencil (6 mm or ¼") at all times when the outside temperature is below freezing. Your consumption is not being metered while receiving water from the bypass system. Instead, your bill is based on a construction flat rate.

The Contractor is diligently working to complete this project and to remove your residence from the temporary water system.

Temporary restoration will be completed this season. Final restoration of sod, landscaping, concrete curb and sidewalk, and permanent asphalt pavement may be carried over to the 2022 construction season depending on weather conditions.

The City of Greater Sudbury maintains an answering service to take your calls 24 hours a day, seven days a week, regarding urgent matters related to municipal infrastructure. Dial 311 to speak with a live operator.
