Public Input Session on Maley Drive Extension

The City of Greater Sudbury is inviting residents and community partners to attend a **public input session** on the **Maley Drive Extension project**, to be held on

**Tuesday, March 1, 2016
at 6 p.m.**

**in the Council Chamber
of Tom Davies Square**

The Maley Drive Extension is a construction project which is expected to provide short-, medium-, and long-term benefits to residents, businesses, and industry. The project is eligible for a three-way cost sharing partnership with senior levels of government.

Phase One of the project will extend LaSalle Boulevard West (near Collège Boréal) to Barry Downe Road. The cost for Phase One is \$80.1 million. The City has more than \$12.2 million in a designated account to permit an immediate start to construction. The Province of Ontario has already committed its one-third share, contingent on a federal announcement.

The public input session is an opportunity for residents and community partners to share their feedback on the project.
