





## Elgin Greenway 2014 Budget



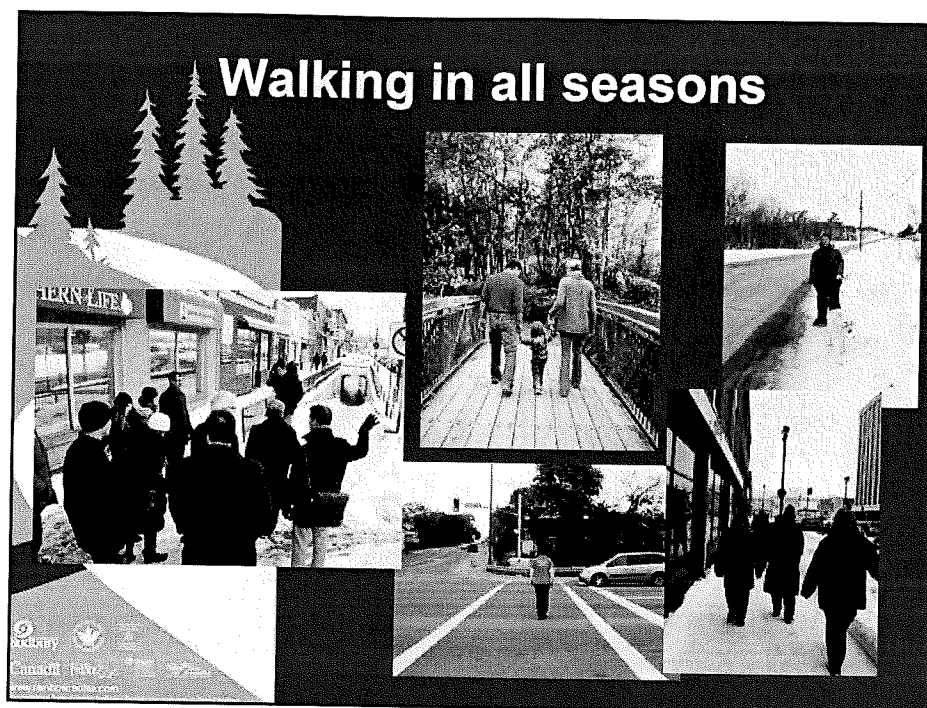

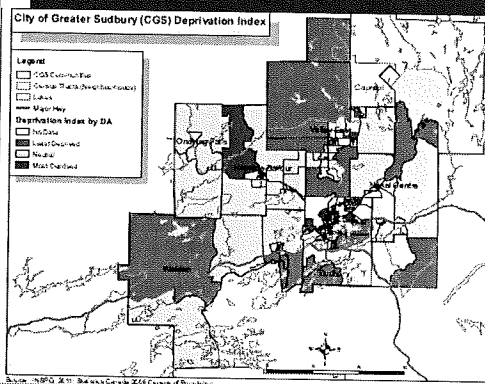
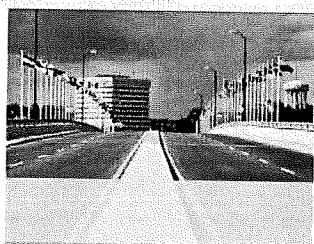
