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Purpose

The purpose of this report to provide City Council with background on this public input meeting relating to Development Charges.

Public Meeting

Under the Development Charges Act, the City must hold at least one public meeting prior to the passage a new Development Charges By-Law.

This public meeting on May 7, 2019 is where residents, business owners and developers can share their input in support of or against development charges based on Development Charges Background Study and related By-Law as per the staff report to the Finance & Administration Committee on March 26, 2019 and available for review on the City's website.

The advertisements for this public meeting were released in local newspapers starting on Thursday, April 11th. Notification of this meeting were also included on the City's website, Citizen Service Centres as well as a recent Development Liaison Advisory Committee (DLAC) meeting along with previous staff report on March 26, 2019 to the Finance & Administration Committee.

These advertisements informed members of the community of the date and location of the public meeting and encouraged them to pre-register with Clerks Services. Presenters will receive five minutes to make a presentation and will be heard in the order they appear on the speakers list.

In addition, written public input and feedback is being accepted either by those submitted to Clerks Services, forms at Citizen Service Centres, as well as on overtoyou.greatersudbury.ca webpage.

All public input received will be provided to City Council in a separate report for the May 28, 2019 meeting.
