#### BY-LAW 2005- 199

# A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY TO AMEND BY-LAW 2005-165 BEING A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY RESPECTING CONSTRUCTION, DEMOLITION, CHANGE OF USE PERMITS, INSPECTIONS AND FEES

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury deems it advisable to amend By-law 2005-165 being a By-law Respecting Construction, Demolition, Change of Use Permits, Inspections and Fees;

## NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. By-law 2005-165 being a By-law Respecting Construction, Demolition, Change of Use Permits, Inspections and Fees is amended by repealing Subsections 61(1) and 61(2) and substituting Subsections 61(1) and 61(2) below in their place and stead:
- "61.-(1) By-law 2001-201B of the City of Greater Sudbury and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
- (2) The repeal of By-law 2001-201B as amended, does not:
  - (a) affect the previous operation of any by-law so repealed;
  - (b) affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued, accruing, or incurred under the by-law so repealed;
  - (c) affect any offence committed against any by-law so repealed or any penalty or forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect thereof; or
  - (d) affect any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of such privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment."
- 2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect retroactively as if it had been passed on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2005, immediately after the passage of 2005-165.
