

BY-LAW 2011-136

**A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY TO AMEND
BY-LAW 2010-214 RESPECTING THE SUPPLY OF WATER,
THE MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE
WATERWORKS SYSTEMS OF THE CITY**

WHEREAS Council for the City of Greater Sudbury deems it advisable to further amend By-law 2010-214, being a By-law Respecting the Supply of Water, the Management and Maintenance of the Waterworks Systems of the City;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY
HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

Enact 4(e-1)

1. By-law 2010-214, being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Respecting the Supply of Water, the Management and Maintenance of the Waterworks Systems of the City, as amended is hereby further amended by enacting the following paragraph 4(e-1) immediately after paragraph 4(e) and before paragraph 4(f):

"4(e-1) Despite sub-paragraphs 4(e)(i) and 4(e)(ii), the owner or occupant of a property may use municipal water for watering freshly laid sod for up to 14 consecutive days."


Effective Date

2. This By-law comes into effect upon final passage.
