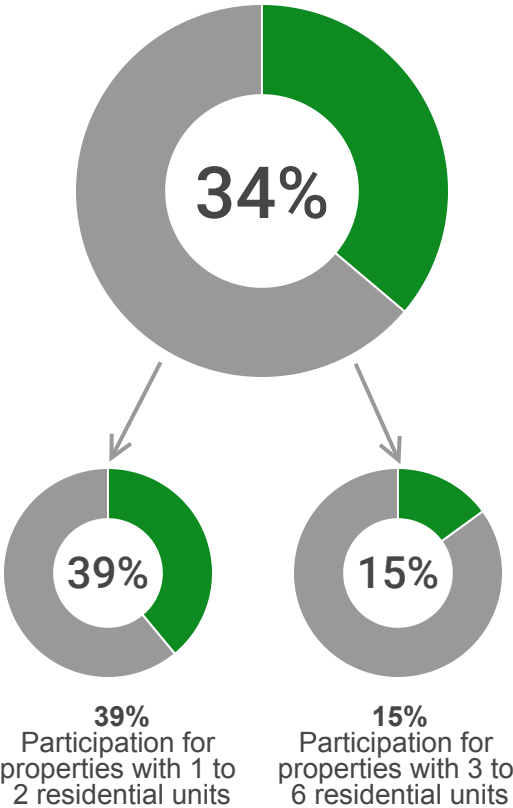


Residential Participation Rate** (2022)

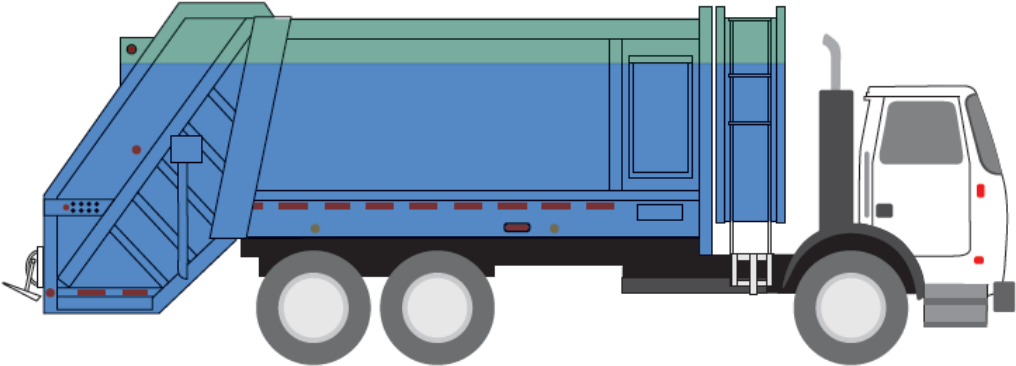

Landfill Quarterly Waste Density Data

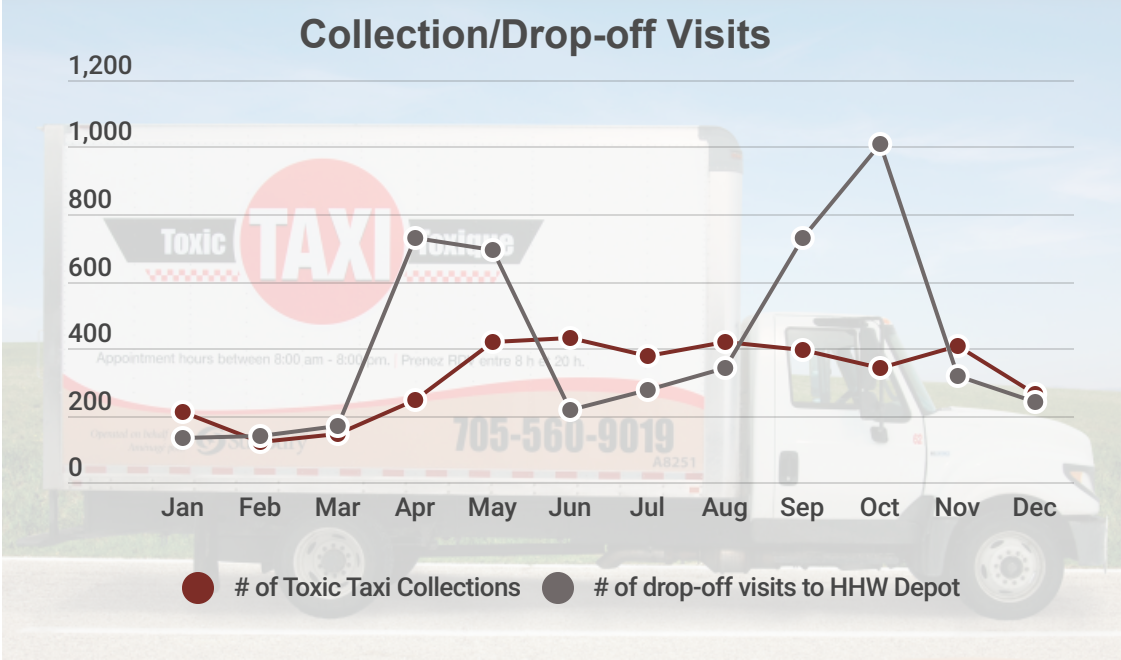
